Superstitions**

Wales has a large mining community that brings with it many superstitions. Here are some of them:

Birds were considered ominous signs when spotted around the pithead. It was an especially bad sign if they were pigeons, robins, or doves. These "corpse birds" were said to have been seen before the Senghenydd Explosion in 1913, when over 400 people were killed. Birds have been seen before many mining disasters.

At the Morfa Colliery in the early months of 1890, there were numerous strange happenings. There was a rose-like smell in the mines, said to be coming from "death flowers". Many said that they saw ghosts and heard ghostly cries for

help. There were flickering lights called "corpse candles" seen in the tunnels. These omens were so strong that over half of the morning crew stayed home on March 10th. Later that day, there was an explosion and 87 miners were buried alive and died.

Not all superstitions were bad. There are also many stories about mine fairies that would knock on parts of the wall where the miners could find the precious metals or minerals.
