Learning to Speak Welsh?

You may have noticed that the Welsh language has a few differences from the English language. Here are some of them:

C - pronounced as a K, as in English 'king' eg: Caernarfon (kyre-nar-von).

CH - pronounced as in the Scottish 'loch'.

DD - pronounced TH, as in English 'breathe' eg: Beddgelert (beth-gell-airt).

G - pronounced as a hard G, as in English 'go' eg: Beddgelert (beth-gell-airt).

LL - roughly pronounced THL eg: Llanberis (thlan-ber-ris)

F - pronounced as a V, as in English 'of' eg: Felindre (veh-lin-dray).

FF - pronounced as an F, as in English 'fly' eg: FFestiniog (fest-in-yog).

W - pronounced as an OO, as in English 'roost' eg: Llanrwst (thlan-roost).

Y - In any place but the last syllable of a word it's pronounced as a U - as in English 'fun'. But, when it is in the last syllable of a word it is pronounced as a i - as in English 'in'. For example, the Welsh for mountain is mynydd (mun-ith) the Welsh for mountains is mynyddoedd (mun-uth-oith). In single syllable words, the Y is unpredictable!

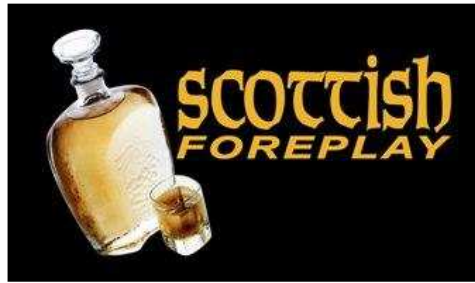

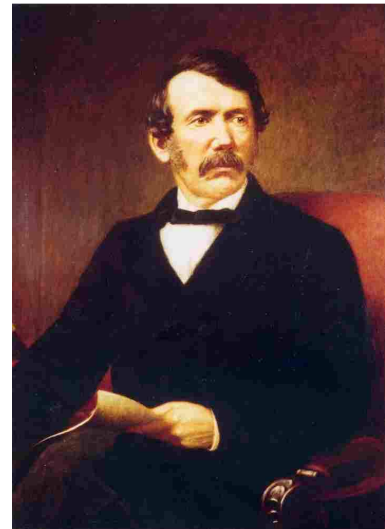

I was born in Scotland in 1813 to a very religious family. At a young age, I read about a need for medical missionaries and immediately wanted to join the cause. I studied medicine while training to become a minister.

After meeting Robert Moffat, I decided to head to South Africa for missionary work. I was attacked by a lion, which severely injured my arm and oddly enough is how they were able to identify my body years later. While in Africa, I did more exploring then evangelizing. I was the first European to fall upon the Smoke that Thunders and renamed it after the Queen. I also discovered many other lakes and rivers and helped to map much of the Upper Zambezi River. I tried to find the source of the Nile, but was unsuccessful.

I lost complete contact with the outside world for 6 years. A Welsh newspaper journalist named Stanley was sent to find me, which eventually he did. I think he was surprised to find me Living. I presume you've heard about that encounter?
