At the age of 16, Patrick was captured by Irish raiders and was taken to Ireland as a slave. While watching his flock of sheep, he turned to religion for solace becoming a devout Christian. After six years, Patrick received a divine message commanding him to return to his family. Upon his return, Patrick entered the church studying to become a deacon and a bishop. With blessing from the pope, Patrick returned to Ireland as a Christian missionary.

As a missionary, Patrick founded 100's of churches which he visited and watched over until his death. Majority of what is known about St. Patrick comes from his two works, *the Confession*, and *Epistola*.

Some see March 17 as a holy day celebrating St. Patrick for bringing Christianity to Ireland. Others see it as a celebration of everything Irish. Another tradition on St. Patrick's Day is that loved ones gather to share a "traditional" meal of corned beef and cabbage.
