St. Andrew, one of the apostles, was a humble fisherman in Galilee. Andrew was sentenced to death for following Christ and preaching the gospel. Feeling unworthy to die as Christ had on a T-shaped cross, he asked to be crucified on an X-shaped cross called a saltire, now featured on the Scottish flag. Andrew was buried in Greece until the Emperor removed his bones and took them to Constantinople. A monk, Rule, had a vision that told him to take as many of the remains as he could to the end of the earth, which at the time was believed to be close to Scotland. Rule was shipwrecked at Kilrymont, now St. Andrews. The remains were placed in a chapel which became St. Andrews Cathedral in 1160. A plaque now marks the place where they were kept. The bones were stolen from Constantinople and taken to Vatican City. A piece of his shoulder blade was sent to the Roman Catholic community of Scotland in 1879. In 1969, Pope Paul VI returned the relics to Scotland. They are now on display in St. Mary's Roman Catholic Cathedral in Edinburgh.
